- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 134.004, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 134.004. JOBS AND EDUCATION FOR TEXANS (JET) GRANT
- 8 PROGRAM. (a) The commission shall establish and administer the
- 9 Jobs and Education for Texans (JET) Grant Program to provide grants
- 10 to public junior colleges, public technical institutes, public
- 11 state colleges, and independent school districts and
- 12 <u>open-enrollment charter schools</u> described under Section 134.007
- 13 that apply to the advisory board in the manner prescribed by the
- 14 advisory board. The commission shall award the grants on the advice
- 15 and recommendations of the advisory board.
- 16 (b) Grants may be awarded under this chapter from the Jobs
- 17 and Education for Texans (JET) fund to defray the start-up costs
- 18 associated with the development of new career and technical
- 19 education programs at public junior colleges, public technical
- 20 institutes, public state colleges, and independent school
- 21 districts and open-enrollment charter schools described under
- 22 Section 134.007 that meet the requirements of Section 134.006.
- SECTION 2. Sections 134.006(a) and (d), Education Code, are
- 24 amended to read as follows:

- 1 (a) The commission may award a grant for the development of 2 new career and technical education courses or programs at public 3 junior colleges, public technical institutes, public state 4 colleges, [and] independent school districts, and open-enrollment 5 charter schools.
- 6 (d) To be eligible to receive a grant under this section, a 7 public junior college, public technical institute, public state college, or independent school district or open-enrollment charter 8 9 school described under Section 134.007 must provide matching funds 10 in accordance with rules adopted under Section 134.008. 11 matching funds may be obtained from any source available to the public junior college, public technical institute, public state 12 13 college, [or open-enrollment school district, or open-enrollment including industry consortia, community or 14 charter school, foundation grants, individual contributions, 15 and local governmental agency operating funds. 16
- SECTION 3. Section 134.007, Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 134.007. GRANTS AWARDED TO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

 OR OPEN-ENROLLMENT CHARTER SCHOOL. The commission may award a

 grant to an independent school district or open-enrollment charter

 school under this chapter if the district or school has entered into

 a partnership with a public junior college, public technical

 institute, or public state college for the purpose of:
- 25 (1) promoting career and technical education to the 26 district's <u>or school's</u> students; or
- 27 (2) offering dual credit courses to the district's or

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- 1 <u>school's</u> students.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
