A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to parental access to public school virtual instruction
- 3 and instructional materials for virtual and remote learning.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 26.006(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) A parent is entitled to:
- 8 (1) review all teaching materials, instructional
- 9 materials, and other teaching aids used in the classroom of the
- 10 parent's child, including while the child is participating in
- 11 <u>virtual or remote learning;</u> [and]
- 12 (2) review each test administered to the parent's
- 13 child after the test is administered; and
- 14 (3) observe virtual instruction while the parent's
- 15 child is participating in virtual or remote learning to the same
- 16 extent the parent would be entitled to observe in-person
- 17 instruction of the child.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
