- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The following provisions of the Health and
- 7 Safety Code are repealed:
- 8 (1) Sections 382.0216(f) and (h); and
- 9 (2) Sections 382.051962(c) and (d).
- 10 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 11 an enforcement action initiated by the Texas Commission on
- 12 Environmental Quality on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 13 enforcement action initiated before the effective date of this Act
- 14 is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective
- 15 date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 16 purpose.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
