- (c) A school district or open-enrollment charter school 12

- 15 (1)be approved by the agency; [and]
- 16 provide the student or the student's parent or
- other person standing in parental relation, as applicable, the 17

- 1 a student has complied with this section for purposes of
- 2 determining whether the student meets high school graduation
- 3 requirements under Section 28.025, the school counselor may only
- 4 indicate whether the student has complied with this section and may
- 5 not indicate the manner in which the student complied. A school
- 6 counselor may not indicate that a student has not complied with this
- 7 section if the school district or open-enrollment charter school
- 8 fails to provide the form adopted under Subsection (c) to the

- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
- 12 school year.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
