A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the determination of student priority in awarding TEXAS

3 grants.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 56.303(d-1) and (f), Education Code,

6 are amended to read as follows:

- 7 (d-1) In allocating among eligible institutions money
- 8 available for initial TEXAS grants for an academic year, the
- 9 coordinating board shall ensure that each of those institutions'
- 10 proportional share of the total amount of money for initial grants
- 11 that is allocated to eligible institutions under this section for
- 12 that year does not, as a result of the number of students who
- 13 establish eligibility at the institution for an initial grant
- 14 awarded under the highest priority as described by Subsection (f)
- 15 [under Section 56.3041(2)(Λ)], change from the institution's
- 16 proportional share of the total amount of money for initial grants
- 17 that is allocated to those institutions under this section for the
- 18 preceding academic year.
- 19 (f) Beginning with TEXAS grants awarded for the 2013-2014
- 20 academic year, in determining who should receive an initial TEXAS
- 21 grant, each eligible institution, in addition to giving priority as
- 22 provided by Subsection (e), shall give highest priority equally to
- 23 students who meet the eligibility criteria described by Sections
- 24 $\underline{56.3041(a)(2)(A)}$ and $\underline{(C)}$ [Section $\underline{56.3041(2)(A)}$]. If there is money

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- 1 available in excess of the amount required to award an initial TEXAS
- 2 grant to all students meeting those criteria, an eligible
- 3 institution shall make awards to other students who meet the
- 4 eligibility criteria described by Section 56.304(a)(2)(A),
- 5 provided that the institution continues to give priority to
- 6 students as provided by Subsection (e).
- 7 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply
- 8 beginning with initial TEXAS grants awarded for the 2022 fall
- 9 semester. Initial TEXAS grants awarded for a semester or term
- 10 before the 2022 fall semester are governed by the applicable law in
- 11 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the
- 12 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
