6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 242, Health and Safety
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 242.0405 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 242.0405. NOTICE OF ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND RELATED
9	DISORDERS CERTIFICATION. (a) A nursing facility advertising,
10	marketing, or otherwise promoting that the facility provides memory
11	care services shall prepare a written notice disclosing whether the
12	facility is certified or is not certified under Section 242.040 to
13	provide specialized care and treatment for facility residents with
14	Alzheimer's disease and related disorders.
15	(b) The nursing facility shall provide the notice described
16	by Subsection (a) to:
17	(1) each facility resident; and
18	(2) each person applying for services from the
19	facility or the person's next of kin or guardian.
20	(c) A nursing facility that provides the notice required
21	under Subsection (a) is not required to include the information
22	described by Section 242.202(d)(2) in a disclosure statement
23	provided under that section.
24	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 247, Health and Safety

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Code, is amended by adding Section 247.0295 to read as follows: 1 2 Sec. 247.0295. NOTICE OF ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE OR RELATED DISORDERS LICENSE CLASSIFICATION. (a) An assisted living facility 3 advertising, marketing, or otherwise promoting that the facility 4 provides memory care services shall provide to each facility 5 resident written notice disclosing whether the facility holds a 6 7 license or does not hold a license classified under Section 247.029 to provide personal care services to residents with Alzheimer's 8 9 disease or related disorders.

10 (b) An assisted living facility that provides the notice 11 required under Subsection (a) is not required under Section 12 247.026(c-1) to include in the facility's consumer disclosure 13 statement information on whether the facility holds a license 14 classified under Section 247.029 to provide personal care services 15 to residents with Alzheimer's disease or related disorders.

16 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date 17 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human 18 Services Commission shall adopt rules to implement Sections 19 242.0405 and 247.0295, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act. 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
