A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the date of dissolution of the Save Historic Muny 3 District.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 3988.0302(d), Special District Local
6 Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 (d) The district may enter into a contract with the city to allow the city to provide to the district revenue from fees 8 9 collected by the city from municipally owned utility customers in the district in exchange for the district providing an improvement 10 project or service that provides a public benefit to the city. The 11 district may not enter into a contract described by this subsection 12 unless the district enters into an agreement before May 31, 2023 13 14 [2021], with the owner of the land used for the historic Lions Municipal Golf Course that provides for the purchase of the land or 15 16 a method of preserving the land as a public golf course, publicly available parkland, or a combination of those uses. 17

SECTION 2. Section 3988.0901, Special District Local Laws Ocde, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3988.0901. DISSOLUTION. Except as limited by Section 375.264, Local Government Code, the board shall dissolve the district not later than May 31, <u>2023</u> [2021], unless, as of that date, the district has entered into an agreement with the owner of the land used for the historic Lions Municipal Golf Course that

1 provides for the purchase of the land or a method of preserving the 2 land as a public golf course, publicly available parkland, or a 3 combination of those uses.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
