## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to state agency enforcement of laws regulating small

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 2006, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 2006.003 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2006.003. OPPORTUNITY TO REMEDY VIOLATION; POLICY.
- 8 (a) This section applies only to a state agency with regulatory
- 9 authority over a small business.
- 10 (b) A state agency may not impose an administrative penalty
- 11 or request imposition of a civil penalty against a small business
- 12 for a first violation of a statute or a rule administered by the
- 13 agency unless the agency first provides the small business written
- 14 notice of the violation and an opportunity to remedy the violation
- 15 within a reasonable time of receipt of the notice. Notwithstanding
- 16 any other law, a violation is not considered to be a continuing
- 17 violation during the reasonable time in which the small business is
- 18 attempting to remedy the violation.
- 19 <u>(c) Each state agency subject to this section shall adopt a</u>
- 20 policy consistent with the requirements of Subsection (b). The
- 21 policy must provide that the agency will not attempt to recover an
- 22 administrative penalty or request imposition of a civil penalty
- 23 during the reasonable time in which the small business is
- 24 attempting to remedy the violation.

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- 1 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2022, each state agency
- 2 shall adopt and implement the policy required by Section 2006.003,
- 3 Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
