A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to mental health services development plans as updated by
- 3 the Health and Human Services Commission and local mental health
- 4 authority groups.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 531.0222 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 531.0222. LOCAL MENTAL HEALTH AUTHORITY GROUP REGIONAL
- 9 PLANNING. (a) In this section, "local mental health authority
- 10 group" means a group of local mental health authorities established
- 11 by the commission under Chapter 963 (S.B. 633), Acts of the 86th
- 12 Legislature, Regular Session, 2019.
- 13 (b) The commission shall require each local mental health
- 14 authority group to meet at least quarterly to collaborate on
- 15 planning and implementing regional strategies to reduce:
- 16 (1) costs to local governments of providing services
- 17 to persons experiencing a mental health crisis;
- 18 (2) transportation to mental health facilities of
- 19 persons served by an authority that is a member of the group;
- 20 (3) incarceration of persons with mental illness in
- 21 county jails that are located in an area served by an authority that
- 22 is a member of the group; and
- 23 (4) visits by persons with mental illness at hospital
- 24 emergency rooms located in an area served by an authority that is a

- 1 member of the group.
- 2 (c) The commission shall use federal funds in accordance
- 3 with state and federal guidelines to implement this section.
- 4 (d) The commission, in coordination with each local mental
- 5 health authority group, shall annually update the mental health
- 6 services development plan that was initially developed by the
- 7 commission and each local mental health authority group under
- 8 Chapter 963 (S.B. 633), Acts of the 86th Legislature, Regular
- 9 Session, 2019. The commission and each group's updated plan must
- 10 include a description of:
- 11 (1) actions taken by the group to implement regional
- 12 strategies in the plan; and
- 13 (2) new regional strategies identified by the group to
- 14 reduce the circumstances described by Subsection (b), including the
- 15 <u>estimated number of outpatient and inpatient beds necessary to meet</u>
- 16 the goals of each group's regional strategy.
- 17 (e) Not later than December 1 of each year, the commission
- 18 shall produce and publish on its Internet website a report
- 19 containing the most recent version of each mental health services
- 20 development plan developed by the commission and a local mental
- 21 health authority group.
- 22 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Section 531.0222, Government
- 23 Code, as added by this Act, a local mental health authority group
- 24 and the Health and Human Services Commission are not required to
- 25 produce or publish a report required by that section before
- 26 December 1, 2022.
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- $4\,$ Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 5 legislative session.
