No. 456 1 (5) a veterans court program established by the 2 commissioners court as provided by Chapter 124; or (6) a veterans county service office established by 3 the commissioners court as provided by Subchapter B, Chapter 434. 4 5 (c) The county treasurer shall: 6 (1) send all donations made under Subsection (a)(1) to 7 the comptroller, at the time and in the manner prescribed by the attorney general, for deposit to the credit of the compensation to 8 9 victims of crime fund; 10 (2) deposit donations made to the county child welfare board under Subsection (a)(2) in a fund established by the county to 11 be used by the child welfare board in a manner authorized by the 12 commissioners court of the county; and 13 (3) send all donations made under Subsection (a)(3), 14 [or] (a)(4), or (a)(6) directly to the program or office, as 15 applicable, specified on the form letter signed by the person who 16 reported for jury service. 17 18 SECTION 2. Section 434.032, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 19 20 (c) The commissioners court of a county that maintains an office: 21 22 (1) may not consider a juror's donation to the office of the juror's daily reimbursement under Section 61.003 for 23 24 purposes of determining the county's budget for the office; and 25 (2) may use donations described by Subdivision (1) only to supplement, rather than supplant, amounts budgeted by the 26 27 county for the office.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
