 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to designating the 11th day of each month as Buddy Check  
 1-18 Day.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is  
 1-21 amended by adding Section 662.083 to read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 662.083. BUDDY CHECK DAY. (a) The 11th day of each  
 1-23 month is Buddy Check Day to encourage veterans to contact other  
 1-24 veterans, including those with whom they served, who may need  
 1-25 assistance.

1-26 (b) Buddy Check Day may be regularly observed by appropriate  
 1-27 programs and activities coordinated by the Texas Veterans  
 1-28 Commission to promote assistance and other services available to  
 1-29 veterans and promote education and awareness of issues facing  
 1-30 veterans.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
