2	relating to a seller's disclosure of the location of certain real

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 5, Property Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 5.020 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 5.020. SELLER'S DISCLOSURE OF LOCATION OF CERTAIN REAL
8	PROPERTY IN FLOODPLAIN. (a) A seller of a tract of real property
9	that measures less than 15 acres and that does not have a residence

- 10 located or being constructed on the property at the time of the sale
- 11 shall provide to the purchaser of the property a written notice
- 12 disclosing whether any part of the property is located in a
- 13 floodplain. If any part of the property is located in a floodplain,
- 14 the notice must include a copy of a current elevation certificate,
- 15 topographical survey, plat, or flood map that indicates the part of
- 16 the property that is located in the floodplain.
- 17 (b) The notice must be delivered by the seller on or before
- 18 the effective date of an executory contract binding the purchaser
- 19 to purchase the property.
- 20 <u>(c) The purchaser is entitled to recover from the seller</u>
- 21 damages caused by flooding on any part of the purchased real
- 22 property that is located in a floodplain if:
- (1) the seller fails to provide the purchaser the
- 24 notice required by this section; and

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- 1 (2) the flooding occurs before the fifth anniversary
- 2 <u>of the date of the purchase.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
