- 6 SECTION 1. Section 48.151, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsection (n) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (h) Funds allotted under this section must be used in
- 10 providing transportation services. Transporting a meal or
- 11 <u>instructional materials as provided by Subsection (n) is included</u>
- 12 <u>in transportation services under this subsection.</u>
- 13 (n) For the duration of a declared disaster, a school
- 14 district located in an area that is wholly or partly the subject of
- 15 a disaster declaration by the governor under Chapter 418,
- 16 Government Code, or by the president of the United States may be
- 17 reimbursed on a per-mile basis for the cost of transporting a meal
- 18 or instructional materials to a student's residence or to another
- 19 <u>location</u>, designated by the district, for pick up by the student.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
