5	SECTION 1. Section 401.201, Occupations Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (b) to read as follows:
7	(b) Notwithstanding any other law, in adopting a rule under
8	this chapter, the commission:
9	(1) shall authorize:
10	(A) a license holder, including a licensed intern
11	or licensed assistant, to provide services by use of any
12	interactive audiovisual communication system, whether real-time or
13	two-way, including a smart phone; and
14	(B) any supervision requirement for an applicant
15	under this chapter to be fulfilled wholly or partly by use of
16	telecommunications technology; and
17	(2) may not:
18	(A) require a license holder 's initial
19	professional contact with a client to be in-person; or
20	(B) impose any limitation on a license holder 's
21	selection of a facilitator to assist the license holder in
22	providing services by use of telecommunications technology.
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
