9	instructional activities delivered to students primarily over the
10	<pre>Internet.</pre>
11	(b) If a school district provides notice to the parent or
12	person standing in parental relation to a student enrolled in the
13	district of the district's intent to offer only virtual instruction
14	for more than one grading period during a school year, the student
15	may transfer for that school year to another school district that:
16	(1) offers in-person instruction during that school
17	year; and
18	(2) accepts the student's transfer.
19	(c) A student who transfers to another school district under
20	this section may not be charged tuition. The student is included in
21	the average daily attendance of the district in which the student

- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
