A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to the prohibited discharge of a patient to certain
- 3 unlicensed or unpermitted group-centered facilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 256, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 256. SAFE PATIENT HANDLING, [AND] MOVEMENT, AND DISCHARGE
- 8 PRACTICES
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 256, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 10 by adding Section 256.003 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 256.003. PROHIBITED DISCHARGE OF PATIENTS TO CERTAIN
- 12 FACILITIES. (a) Subject to Subsection (b), a hospital or other
- 13 health facility may discharge or otherwise release a patient to the
- 14 care of a group home, boarding home facility, or similar
- 15 group-centered facility only if the person who operates the
- 16 <u>facility holds a license or permit issued in accordance with</u>
- 17 applicable state law.
- 18 (b) A hospital or other health facility may discharge or
- 19 otherwise release a patient to the care of a group home, boarding
- 20 home facility, or similar group-centered facility operated by a
- 21 person who does not hold a license or permit issued in accordance
- 22 with applicable state law only if:
- 23 (1) no facility described by this section is operated
- 24 in the county by a person who holds the applicable license or

- 1 permit; or
- 2 (2) the patient voluntarily elects to reside in the
- 3 facility of the unlicensed or unpermitted person.
- 4 (c) A hospital or other health facility is not liable for
- 5 damages to a patient resulting from the patient's discharge or
- 6 release to a group home, boarding home facility, or similar
- 7 group-centered facility under Subsection (b).
- 8 <u>(d) A local health authority may not issue an order</u>
- 9 authorizing a hospital or health facility to discharge or release a
- 10 patient to a facility in a manner that conflicts with this section.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
