## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to an annual report regarding certain dog bites.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 822, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 822.008 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 822.008. ANNUAL REPORT OF DOG BITES. Each animal
7	control authority shall submit to the Department of State Health
8	Services in the form and manner prescribed by the department an
9	annual report regarding dog bites that occurred in the preceding
10	year in the authority's jurisdiction and resulted in bodily injury,
11	serious bodily injury, or death of a person. The report must
12	include the following information for each dog bite:
13	(1) the date of the dog bite;
14	(2) the county or municipality in which the dog bite
15	occurred;
16	(3) the age of the victim of the dog bite;
17	(4) the breed of the dog that caused the dog bite;
18	(5) whether the dog bite resulted in bodily injury,
19	serious bodily injury, or death;
20	(6) whether the victim as a result of the injuries
21	sustained received:
22	(A) emergency medical treatment at an emergency
23	medical care facility or hospital emergency room; or
24	(B) inpatient treatment at a hospital;

- 1 (7) whether the dog was previously determined to be a
- 2 <u>dangerous dog under Subchapter D;</u>
- 3 (8) whether the dog had previously bitten a person,
- 4 resulting in bodily injury, serious bodily injury, or death; and
- 5 (9) whether as a result of the dog bite a person was
- 6 charged with a criminal offense under this chapter or any other law.
- 7 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Section 822.008, Health and
- 8 Safety Code, as added by this Act, an animal control authority is
- 9 not required to submit a report until December 1, 2022.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
