- 5 SECTION 1. Section 521.050(a), Transportation Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

- 9 individual, the department may provide a purchaser, in a format
- 10 prescribed by the department and acceptable to the purchaser, the
- 11 names, addresses, and dates of birth of all license holders that are
- 12 contained in the department's basic driver's license record file if
- 13 the purchaser certifies in writing that the purchaser:
- 14 (1) is eligible to receive the information under
- 15 Chapter 730; and

- 16 (2) has not experienced a breach of system security,
- 17 as defined by Section 521.053, Business & Commerce Code, in the
- 18 previous five years.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 521.050, Transportation Code, as amended
- 20 by this Act, applies only to the disclosure by the Department of
- 21 Public Safety of driver's license information in response to a
- 22 request for the information that is made on or after the effective
- 23 date of this Act. The disclosure by the Department of Public Safety
- 24 of driver's license information in response to a request for the

- 1 information that is made before the effective date of this Act is
- 2 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 3 of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 4 purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
