4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 15.051(a), Election Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(a) If the registrar receives notice under Section 13.146,
8	14.023, 15.053, 16.0921, or 18.0681(d) or otherwise has reason to
9	believe that a voter's current residence is different from that
10	indicated on the registration records, the registrar shall deliver
11	to the voter a written confirmation notice requesting confirmation
12	of the voter's current residence.
13	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 15, Election Code, is
14	amended by adding Section 15.054 to read as follows:
15	Sec. 15.054. CONFIRMATION NOTICE AFTER EVIDENCE OF CHANGE
16	OF RESIDENCE. (a) At least annually the registrar shall:
17	(1) request from the United States Postal Service any
18	available information, including information from the National
19	Change of Address database, indicating address reclassifications
20	or changes of address affecting the registered voters of the
21	county; and
22	(2) for each voter in the county who fails to vote in
23	any election, submit an application for a ballot to be voted by mail
24	under Chapter 84 or 101, or submit a change in voter registration

under Chapter 13 or 15 for two years from the date of a general 1 election for state and county officers, examine real property sales 2 and other public records to determine whether the voter changed 3 residence to a location outside of the county. 4 5 (b) If information obtained under Subsection (a) gives the registrar reason to believe a voter has changed the voter's 6 7 residence to a location outside of the county, the registrar shall deliver a confirmation notice to the voter in accordance with 8

10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
