Section 48.106(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 (a) For each full-time equivalent student in average daily 7 attendance in an approved career and technology education program 8 9 in grades 7 through 12, a district is entitled to: (1) an annual allotment equal to the basic allotment, 10 11 or, if applicable, the sum of the basic allotment and the allotment under Section 48.101 to which the district is entitled, multiplied 12 by a weight of 1.35; and 13 14 (2) \$50 for each of the following in which the student is enrolled: 15 (A) 16 two or more advanced career and technology education classes for a total of three or more credits; 17 18 a campus designated as a P-TECH school under (B) Section 29.556; or 19 a campus that is a member of the New Tech 20 (C) 21 Network and that focuses on project-based learning and work-based education. 22 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
