A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to bonds issued by and the dissolution of municipal
3	management districts.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter M , Chapter 375, Local Government
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 375.2621 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 375.2621. PROHIBITION ON ISSUANCE OF BONDS AFTER
8	PETITION. The district may not issue bonds after the date a
9	petition for dissolution under Section 375.262 is filed with the
10	board.
11	SECTION 2. Section 375.264, Local Government Code, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Sec. 375.264. <u>LIMITATIONS</u> [LIMITATION] ON DISSOLUTION BY
14	BOARD OF DISTRICT WITH DEBT. (a) A district may not be dissolved by
15	its board <u>under Section 375.261</u> or after a petition is filed under
16	Section 375.262 if the district has [any] outstanding bonded
17	indebtedness until that bonded indebtedness has been repaid or
18	defeased in accordance with the order or resolution authorizing the
19	issuance of the bonds.

- (b) After a petition is filed under Section 375.262 with the
- 21 board of a district that has outstanding bonded indebtedness:
- 22 (1) the district shall remain in existence solely for
- 23 the purpose of discharging its bonded indebtedness; and
- 24 (2) the board shall use all district money that is

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- 1 available for the purpose to repay or defease all bonded
- 2 indebtedness as soon as practicable in accordance with the order or
- 3 resolution authorizing the issuance of the bonds.
- 4 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 5 a municipal management district that is the subject of a petition
- 6 described by Section 375.262, Local Government Code, filed with the
- 7 board on or after the effective date of this Act. A district that is
- 8 the subject of such a petition filed with the board before the
- 9 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 10 date the petition was filed, and the former law is continued in
- 11 effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act may not be
- 13 construed to impair an obligation under a contract entered into
- 14 before the effective date of this Act. A political subdivision may
- 15 fulfill the subdivision's obligations under a contract entered into
- 16 before that date but may not extend such a contract beyond the
- 17 contract's original term.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
