## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the allocation of low income housing tax credits.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 2306.67022, Government Code, is amended 5 to read as follows:

6 Sec. 2306.67022. QUALIFIED ALLOCATION PLAN; MANUAL. <u>The</u> 7 [At least biennially, the] board <u>biennially</u> shall adopt a qualified 8 allocation plan and a corresponding manual to provide information 9 regarding the administration of and eligibility for the low income 10 housing tax credit program. The board may <u>not</u> adopt <u>a</u> [the] plan 11 and manual <u>more frequently than once during each biennium</u> 12 [annually, as considered appropriate by the board].

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 13 14 to an application for low income housing tax credits that is submitted to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs 15 16 during an application cycle that is based on the 2020 qualified allocation plan or a subsequent plan adopted by the governing board 17 of the department under Section 2306.67022, Government Code, as 18 amended by this Act. An application that is submitted during an 19 application cycle that is based on an earlier qualified allocation 20 plan is governed by the law in effect on the date the application 21 cycle began, and the former law is continued in effect for that 22 23 purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
