 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the sale of distilled spirits to ultimate consumers by
 1-21 the holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Sections 14.05(c) and (f), Alcoholic Beverage
 1-24 Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-25 (c) The holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit may
 1-26 not under Subsection (b) sell more than four ~~[two]~~ 750 milliliter
 1-27 bottles of distilled spirits or the equivalent to the same consumer
 1-28 within a 30-day period.

1-29 (f) The permit holder must ~~[check a purchaser's~~
 1-30 ~~identification and]~~ keep records of sales ~~[purchases]~~ in a manner
 1-31 that enables the permit holder to comply with this section.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
