1-19 relating to the continuation of the Red River Boundary Commission.  
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section 12.057(b), Natural Resources Code, is  
 1-22 amended to read as follows:  
 1-23 (b) Not later than July 30, 2023 [~~2021~~], the commission  
 1-24 shall issue a final report to the governor, lieutenant governor,  
 1-25 speaker of the house of representatives, and appropriate committees  
 1-26 of the legislature.  
 1-27 SECTION 2. Section 12.058, Natural Resources Code, is  
 1-28 amended to read as follows:  
 1-29 Sec. 12.058. EXPIRATION OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter  
 1-30 expires December 31, 2023 [~~2021~~].  
 1-31 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-32 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-33 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-35 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
