- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 213.032(a), Labor Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) A notice of assessment shall be served on a defaulting
- 9 employer by one of the following methods:
- 10 (1) in the manner provided by law for service of
- 11 process on a defendant in a civil action in district court;
- 12 (2) by registered or certified mail, return receipt
- 13 requested, or similar common carrier method to the employer's last
- 14 known address as shown by commission records; or
- 15 (3) in another manner that is reasonably calculated to
- 16 give the employer actual notice of the assessment, but only after an
- 17 attempt to serve a notice of the assessment in a manner described by
- 18 Subdivision (1) or (2) has been unsuccessful.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
