A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the award of attorney's fees and other costs in an 3 eminent domain proceeding.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.047, Property Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) If the amount of damages awarded by the special
- 8 commissioners is at least 20 percent greater than the amount of the
- 9 condemnor's final offer made in accordance with Section 21.0113, or
- 10 if the commissioners' award is appealed and a court awards damages
- 11 in an amount that is at least 20 percent greater than the amount of
- 12 the condemnor's final offer made in accordance with Section
- 13 <u>21.0113</u>, the condemnor:
- 14 (1) shall pay all costs as provided by Subsection (a);
- 15 and

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- 16 (2) may be required to pay reasonable attorney's fees
- 17 and other professional fees incurred by the property owner in
- 18 connection with the eminent domain proceeding.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 21.047(a-1), Property Code, as added by
- 20 this Act, applies only to an eminent domain proceeding commenced on
- 21 or after the effective date of this Act. An eminent domain
- 22 proceeding commenced before the effective date of this Act is
- 23 governed by the law applicable to the proceeding immediately before
- 24 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect

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- 1 for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
