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- 2 relating to certain prohibited practices by pharmacy benefit
- 3 managers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 4151.151, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 4151.151. DEFINITIONS [DEFINITION]. In this
- 8 subchapter:
- 9 (1) "Affiliated pharmacist or pharmacy" means a
- 10 pharmacist or pharmacy that directly, or indirectly through one or
- 11 more intermediaries, controls or is controlled by, or is under
- 12 common control with, a pharmacy benefit manager.
- 13 (2) "Pharmacy [, "pharmacy] benefit manager" means a
- 14 person, other than a pharmacy or pharmacist, who acts as an
- 15 administrator in connection with pharmacy benefits.
- 16 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 4151, Insurance Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Sections 4151.155 and 4151.156 to read as
- 18 follows:
- 19 Sec. 4151.155. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN REFERRALS. (a) A
- 20 pharmacy benefit manager may not steer or direct a patient to use an
- 21 affiliated pharmacist or pharmacy through any oral or written
- 22 <u>communication</u>, including:
- 23 (1) online messaging regarding the pharmacist or
- 24 pharmacy; or

- 1 (2) patient- or prospective patient-specific
- 2 advertising, marketing, or promotion of the pharmacist or pharmacy.
- 3 (b) This section does not prohibit a pharmacy benefit
- 4 manager from including an affiliated pharmacist or pharmacy in the
- 5 manager's patient communications, including in a patient- or
- 6 prospective patient-specific communication, if the communication:
- 7 (1) is regarding in-network pharmacies and prices for
- 8 a health benefit plan;
- 9 (2) is accurate; and
- 10 <u>(3) includes in-network pharmacists or pharmacies</u>
- 11 that are not affiliated pharmacists or pharmacies.
- 12 <u>(c) An affiliated pharmacist or pharmacy may not present a</u>
- 13 claim for payment to any individual or entity, including to a
- 14 third-party payor, health benefit plan, or pharmacy benefit
- 15 manager, for a health care service or supply provided to a patient
- 16 who was improperly steered or directed to use the affiliated
- 17 pharmacist or pharmacy in violation of Subsection (a).
- 18 Sec. 4151.156. PROHIBITION ON SHARING PATIENT INFORMATION
- 19 FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES. (a) In this section, "commercial purpose"
- 20 does not include pharmacy reimbursement, formulary compliance,
- 21 pharmaceutical care, utilization review by a health care provider,
- 22 or a public health activity authorized by law.
- 23 (b) A pharmacy benefit manager may not transfer to or
- 24 receive from an affiliated pharmacist or pharmacy a record
- 25 containing patient- or prescriber-identifiable prescription
- 26 information for a commercial purpose.
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
