1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to requiring the parent of a student enrolled in a school  
 1-22 district to provide and update a student's contact information.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Education Code, is amended by adding  
 1-25 Section 26.0125 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 26.0125. STUDENT CONTACT INFORMATION REQUIRED. The  
 1-27 parent of a student enrolled in a school district shall provide in  
 1-28 writing to the district:

1-29 (1) on enrollment of the student in the district and  
 1-30 not later than two weeks after the beginning of each school year,  
 1-31 the student's address, phone number, and e-mail address; and

1-32 (2) if the student's contact information changes  
 1-33 during the school year, not later than two weeks after the date the  
 1-34 information changes, the student's updated information.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022  
 1-36 school year.

1-37 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-38 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-39 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-40 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-41 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
