A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the notice requirements for permits for the commercial surface disposal of oil and gas wastes. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 91.116, Natural Resources Code, 5 is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (e) to 6 read as follows: 7 (b) A person who files an application for a permit for a 8 9 commercial surface disposal facility shall provide [publish] notice of the application in accordance with this section. 10 11 (e) In addition to publishing notice of the permit 12 application as required by Subsection (d), the applicant shall give notice of the permit application to a river authority or 13 14 groundwater conservation district whose territory contains the tract of land on which a disposal pit will be located or on which the 15 16 disposal will take place. SECTION 2. Section 91.116, Natural Resources Code, 17 as amended by this Act, applies only to an application for an oil and 18 gas waste disposal permit that is filed on or after the effective 19 20 date of this Act. An application for a permit filed before the 21 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the

22 date of filing, and that law is continued in effect for that 23 purpose.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
