- 2 relating to the review by local governmental entities of certain
- 3 sales and use tax audit reports and audit working papers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 321.510(c), (d), (e), and (g), Tax
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) Subject to the criteria provided by this section, a
- 8 municipality or local governmental entity may request a review of
- 9 all available sales tax returns, [and] reports, audit reports, and
- 10 audit working papers in the comptroller's possession filed by not
- 11 more than five individual taxpayers doing business in the
- 12 municipality or local governmental entity that are included and
- 13 identified by the municipality or local governmental entity from
- 14 the information received from the comptroller under Section
- 15 321.3022 and that relate to a reallocation or refund in an amount
- 16 described by Subsection (b).
- 17 (d) The comptroller shall provide the returns, [and]
- 18 reports, audit reports, and audit working papers requested under
- 19 Subsection (c) for review regardless of whether the information [in
- 20 the returns or reports] is confidential under state law, including
- 21 Sections 111.006 and 151.027.
- (e) The provision of confidential information to a
- 23 municipality or local governmental entity under this section does
- 24 not affect the confidential nature of the information in the

- 1 returns, [or] reports, audit reports, or audit working papers. A
- 2 municipality or local governmental entity shall use the information
- 3 only in a manner that maintains the confidential nature of the
- 4 information and may not disclose or release the information to the
- 5 public.
- 6 (g) Not earlier than the 30th day or later than the 90th day
- 7 after the date the comptroller receives a request under Subsection
- 8 (c), the comptroller shall provide the requested returns, [and]
- 9 reports, audit reports, and audit working papers to the requesting
- 10 municipality or local governmental entity for review.
- 11 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 12 a request under Section 321.510(f), Tax Code, submitted on or after
- 13 the effective date of this Act. A request submitted before that date
- 14 is governed by the law in effect when the request was submitted, and
- 15 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
