6	SECTION 1. Title 7, Government Code, is amended by adding
7	Chapter 793 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 793. INTERGOVERNMENTAL SUPPORT AGREEMENTS
9	Sec. 793.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "local
10	government" has the meaning assigned by Section 791.003.
11	Sec. 793.002. AUTHORITY TO ENTER AGREEMENT. In accordance
12	with the provisions that apply to an interlocal contract under
13	Chapter 791, a local government may enter into an intergovernmental
14	support agreement with a branch of the armed forces of the United
15	States under the National Defense Authorization Act (10 U.S.C.
16	Section 2679) to provide installation-support services to a
17	military installation located in this state.
18	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
19	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
20	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
21	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
