1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the authority of a local government to enter into an
1-18 intergovernmental support agreement with a branch of the armed
1-19 forces of the United States.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Title 7, Government Code, is amended by adding
1-22 Chapter 793 to read as follows:

1-23 CHAPTER 793. INTERGOVERNMENTAL SUPPORT AGREEMENTS

1-24 Sec. 793.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "local
1-25 government" has the meaning assigned by Section 791.003.

1-26 Sec. 793.002. AUTHORITY TO ENTER AGREEMENT. In accordance
1-27 with the provisions that apply to an interlocal contract under
1-28 Chapter 791, a local government may enter into an intergovernmental
1-29 support agreement with a branch of the armed forces of the United
1-30 States under the National Defense Authorization Act (10 U.S.C.
1-31 Section 2679) to provide installation-support services to a
1-32 military installation located in this state.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
