## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to authorizing the sale of certain real property by the
- 3 State of Texas to the Port of Corpus Christi Authority of Nueces
- 4 County, Texas.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. (a) The real property described by Section 2 of
- 7 this Act was originally submerged land purchased by the Port of
- 8 Corpus Christi from the State of Texas in 1956 pursuant to Article
- 9 8225, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas. Following the conveyance,
- 10 the submerged land was artificially filled and subsequently leased
- 11 to a third party for non-navigation related purposes. Following
- 12 litigation between the port and the State of Texas, the parties
- 13 entered into a settlement agreement pursuant to which the real
- 14 property was conveyed back to the State. The port now wishes to use
- 15 the real property for navigation-related purposes.
- 16 (b) Accordingly, subject to subsections (c), (d), and (e) of
- 17 this section, the State of Texas shall convey the real property
- 18 described by Section 2 of this Act to the Port of Corpus Christi
- 19 Authority of Nueces County, Texas, to be used by the port only for
- 20 purposes reasonably related to the promotion of navigation as
- 21 defined under Section 61.116(b), Water Code.
- (c) The real property described by Section 2 of this Act may
- 23 not be conveyed by the State of Texas to the Port of Corpus Christi
- 24 Authority of Nueces County, Texas, for an amount less than the fair

- 1 market value of the real property. The fair market value of the real
- 2 property must be established by an independent appraisal obtained
- 3 by the asset management division of the General Land Office.
- 4 (d) The proceeds from the sale of real property authorized
- 5 by this Act must be paid to the State of Texas for the benefit of the
- 6 permanent school fund, including royalties in all oil, gas, and
- 7 other minerals in and under the real property described by Section 2
- 8 of this Act.
- 9 (e) The conveyance of the real property described by Section
- 10 2 of this Act shall be made subject to all covenants, conditions,
- 11 reservations, restrictions, rights of way, easements and leases, if
- 12 any, that are valid, in existence, and of record, or are apparent by
- 13 visual inspection.
- 14 (f) The port may not lease the real property described by
- 15 Section 2 of this Act for a use which is not reasonably related to
- 16 the promotion of navigation as defined under Section 61.116(b),
- 17 Water Code, and may not dispose of the real property except to sell
- 18 or exchange such property with the State of Texas in accordance with
- 19 Section 61.117(f), Water Code.
- 20 (g) Sections 31.1571, 31.158, and 31.159, Natural Resources
- 21 Code, do not apply to the sale of real property authorized by this
- 22 Act.
- 23 SECTION 2. The real property held by the State of Texas is
- 24 submerged and filled submerged land being 33.26 acres of real
- 25 property, more or less, located in Nueces County, Texas, and more
- 26 particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:
- 27 BEGINNING at a 5/8" steel rod found to replace the original

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1 corner "P" marking the original meanders of Nueces Bay as shown on said map recorded in Volume 1251, Page 340, Deed 2 3 Nueces County, Texas, said corner coordinates of N 17194856.64, E 1344097.53, Texas South Zone 4 4205, NAD 83, combined scale factor 1.000005016, for an 5 exterior corner in the south line of this tract; 6 THENCE, S-66°-42'-47"-W, along said original 7 shoreline meander, a distance of 254.92v, 708.10' to a 5/8" steel rod 8 set to replace called corner "O" for the most southerly 9 10 corner of this tract; THENCE, N-53°-59'-13"-W, continuing along original shoreline 11 meanders, a distance of 147.38v, 409.40' to a point which 12 falls in the water for an interior corner in the south line of 13 this tract; 14 15 THENCE, S-85°-15'-47"-W, continuing along original shoreline meanders, a distance of 44.86v, 124.60' to a point which 16 17 falls in the water at the intersection of said shoreline meanders with the southeast bulkhead line of Canal B as shown 18 19 on said map for the west corner of this tract; THENCE, N-31  $^{\circ}$ -34'-47"-E, a distance of 577.00v, 1602.79' to a 20 point in the water at the intersection of said Canal B 21 bulkhead line with the Rincon Canal bulkhead line for the 22 north corner of this tract; 23 24 THENCE,  $S-58^{\circ}-25'-13''-E$ , a distance of 504.00v, 1400.00' to a point in the water at the intersection of said Rincon Canal 25 26 bulkhead line with the Canal A bulkhead line for the east corner of this tract; 27

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THENCE,  $S-31^{\circ}-34'-47''-W$ , a distance of 142.04v, 394.57' to a 1 point in the water at the intersection of said Canal A 2 bulkhead line with the original shoreline meanders for the 3 4 southeast corner of this tract; THENCE, N- $47^{\circ}$ -19'-13"-W, along said original shoreline, a 5 distance of 204.22v, 567.29' to a 5/8" steel rod set to 6 replace called corner "Q" for an interior corner of this 7 8 tract: THENCE, S-25°-36'-47"-W, along said original shoreline, a 9 distance of 252.00v, 700.00' to the POINT OF BEGINNING and 10 containing 33.26-acres of land, more or less. 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 14 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 16
