1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the expiration of a school marshal license issued or
 1-22 renewed by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 1701.260(g), Occupations Code, is
 1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (g) A person's license under this section expires on August
 1-27 31 following ~~[the first birthday of the person occurring after]~~ the
 1-28 second anniversary of the date the commission licenses the person.
 1-29 A renewed school marshal license expires on August 31 ~~[the person's~~
 1-30 ~~birth date]~~, two years after the expiration of the previous
 1-31 license.

1-32 SECTION 2. Section 1701.260(g), Occupations Code, as
 1-33 amended by this Act, applies to a license issued or renewed under
 1-34 that section regardless of whether the license was issued or
 1-35 renewed before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.

1-36 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
