The agency, the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, and the Texas Workforce 9 10 Commission jointly shall develop and make available the following model data-sharing agreements for sharing information subject to 11 12 the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (20 U.S.C. 13 Section 1232g) for purposes of system evaluation and improved 14 support of students and workforce preparation participants: 15 (1) a model data-sharing agreement for public schools and public and private institutions of higher education to share 16 that information with entities authorized to receive that 17 information for use in ongoing system evaluation and improvement 18 purposes or whose employees or contractors are school officials for 19 purposes of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974; 20 21 and 22 (2) a model data-sharing agreement for reciprocal 23 sharing of that information between: 24 (A) public schools;
