- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 8, Local Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Chapter 255 to read as follows:
- 8 CHAPTER 255. CONVERSION OF PROPERTY FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES
- 9 Sec. 255.001. SPECIAL HEARING AND NOTICE REQUIREMENTS FOR
- 10 CONVERSION OF PROPERTY TO HOUSE HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS. (a) Except
- 11 as provided by Subsection (e), the governing body of a municipality
- 12 may not approve the conversion of a property under the
- 13 municipality's control for the purpose of providing housing to
- 14 homeless individuals unless the governing body holds a public
- 15 hearing not less than 90 days before the municipality begins to
- 16 convert the property for that purpose. The hearing must be held at
- 17 <u>a location within a one-mile radius of the property.</u>
- 18 (b) Not later than 36 hours before a public hearing required
- 19 under Subsection (a) is held, the governing body of a municipality
- 20 <u>must provide notice of the hearing by mail to each residence located</u>
- 21 within a one-mile radius of the property the municipality proposes
- 22 to convert for a purpose described by that subsection.
- 23 (c) If the governing body of a municipality fails to comply
- 24 with this section, an individual who is entitled to notice under

- 1 Subsection (b) may bring an action in a district court in the county
- 2 in which the property described by that subsection is located for
- 3 injunctive relief to prevent the conversion of the property.
- 4 (d) In the event of a conflict between this chapter and any
- 5 provision in the charter of a municipality relating to the
- 6 conversion or notice of the conversion of a property for a purpose
- 7 described by Subsection (a), this chapter controls.
- 8 <u>(e) This section does not apply to the conversion of a</u>
- 9 property to provide temporary shelter or housing during a natural
- 10 disaster, declared state of emergency, or other life-threatening
- 11 public emergency.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 255, Local Government Code, as added by
- 13 this Act, applies only to the conversion of property described by
- 14 Section 255.001(a), Local Government Code, as added by this Act,
- 15 that is set to begin on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
