18	auditorium, and cafeteria].
19	(b) A poster or framed copy of the national motto described
20	by Subsection (a):
21	(1) must contain a representation of the United States
22	flag centered under the national motto and a representation of the
23	state flag; and
24	(2) may not depict any words, images, or other

1 information other than the representations listed in Subdivision
2 (1).

3 (c) A public elementary or secondary school and an 4 institution of higher education may accept and use private 5 donations for the purposes of Subsection (a).

6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
