- 14 TRIBE. (a) The Tap Pilam Coahuiltecan Nation is designated and
- 15 recognized by this state as a Native American Indian Tribe
- 16 exercising substantial governmental powers and duties.
- 17 (b) The tribe is recognized as eligible for all programs,
- 18 services, and other benefits provided to state-recognized Native
- 19 American Indian Tribes by the United States, this state, or any
- 20 other state because of the tribe members' status as Native American
- 21 Indians.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
