- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 14, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended 6 by adding Section 14.09 to read as follows:

- Sec. 14.09. SALES AT TEMPORARY LOCATION. (a) The holder of
- 8 <u>a distiller's and rectifier's permit may sell distilled spirits at a</u>
- 9 civic or distilled spirits festival, farmers' market, celebration,
- 10 or similar event.

- 11 (b) The holder of a distiller's and rectifier's permit may
- 12 <u>not offer distilled spirits for sale under this section on more than</u>
- 13 four consecutive days at the same location.
- (c) The commission shall adopt rules to implement this
- 15 section, including rules that:
- 16 (1) require the permit holder to notify the commission
- 17 of the dates on which and location where the permit holder will
- 18 temporarily offer distilled spirits for sale under this section;
- 19 (2) establish a procedure to verify the wet or dry
- 20 status of the location where the permit holder intends to
- 21 temporarily sell distilled spirits under this section;
- 22 (3) detail the circumstances when a permit holder may
- 23 temporarily sell distilled spirits under this section with just a
- 24 notification to the commission and the circumstances that require

- 1 the commission's preapproval before a permit holder may temporarily
- 2 sell distilled spirits under this section; and
- 3 (4) require the permit holder to provide any other
- 4 <u>information the commission determines necessary.</u>
- 5 (d) The provisions of this code applicable to the sale of
- 6 distilled spirits on the permitted premises of the holder of a
- 7 distiller's and rectifier's permit apply to the sale of distilled
- 8 spirits under this section.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
