1 AN ACT relating to the exclusion of certain car haulers from the 2 3 definition of tow truck for purposes of certain laws regulating 4 motor vehicle towing. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 2308.002(11), Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 "Tow truck" means a motor vehicle, including a 8 (11)wrecker, equipped with a mechanical device used to tow, winch, or 9 otherwise move another motor vehicle. The term does not include: 10 (A) a motor vehicle owned and operated by a 11 12 governmental entity, including a public school district; 13 (B) a motor vehicle towing: 14 (i) a race car; (ii) a motor vehicle for exhibition; or 15 (iii) an antique motor vehicle; 16 (C) 17 а recreational vehicle towing another vehicle; 18 a motor vehicle used in combination with a 19 (D) tow bar, tow dolly, or other mechanical device if the vehicle is not 20 operated in the furtherance of a commercial enterprise; 21 22 (E) a motor vehicle that is controlled or 23 operated by a farmer or rancher and used for towing a farm vehicle; (F) a motor vehicle that: 24

No. 860 1 (i) is owned or operated by an entity the 2 primary business of which is the rental of motor vehicles; and 3 (ii) only tows vehicles rented by the 4 entity; 5 (G) a truck-trailer combination that is owned or operated by a dealer licensed under Chapter 2301 and used to 6 7 transport new vehicles during the normal course of a documented transaction in which the dealer is a party and ownership or the 8 9 right of possession of the transported vehicle is conveyed or 10 transferred; or 11 (H) a car hauler that is used solely to transport, other than in a consent or nonconsent tow, motor 12 13 vehicles as cargo: (i) in the course of: 14 15 (a) a prearranged shipping 16 transaction; or 17 (b) a commercial transaction for 18 transport of a damaged vehicle arranged or authorized by an insurance company and delivered to a salvage pool operator as 19 defined by Section 2302.001; or 20 21 (ii) for use in mining, drilling, or construction operations. 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 23
