- 2 relating to the expiration of the dry cleaner environmental
- 3 response program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 374.253(a), (b), and (c), Health and
- 6 Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) This chapter expires on September 1, 2041 [2021].
- 8 (b) A corrective action, including any administrative
- 9 duties associated with the action, for which remediation of a
- 10 contaminated site has begun before September 1, 2041 [2021], shall
- 11 be completed in accordance with this chapter using money from the
- 12 fund, to the extent possible, but money may not be collected for or
- 13 added to the fund on or after that date.
- 14 (c) The commission may continue a corrective action that has
- 15 not progressed beyond the investigative or planning stage after
- 16 September 1, $\underline{2041}$ [$\underline{2021}$], to the extent money from the fund is
- 17 available.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
