A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the expiration of the dry cleaner environmental 3 response program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 374.253(a), (b), and (c), Health and 6 Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:

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(a) This chapter expires on September 1, 2041 [2021].

8 (b) A corrective action, including any administrative 9 duties associated with the action, for which remediation of a 10 contaminated site has begun before September 1, <u>2041</u> [2021], shall 11 be completed in accordance with this chapter using money from the 12 fund, to the extent possible, but money may not be collected for or 13 added to the fund on or after that date.

14 (c) The commission may continue a corrective action that has 15 not progressed beyond the investigative or planning stage after 16 September 1, <u>2041</u> [2021], to the extent money from the fund is 17 available.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
