SECTION 1. Section 1510.012(a), Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. Section 1510.013, Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1510.013. EXPIRATION OF CHAPTER. This chapter expires August 31,

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
