## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

| 4  | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:             |
| 5  | SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 214, Local Government              |
| 6  | Code, is amended by adding Section 214.220 to read as follows:      |
| 7  | Sec. 214.220. INSPECTION DURING DECLARED DISASTER. (a) In           |
| 8  | an area of a municipality that is subject to a declaration of       |
| 9  | disaster by the governor under Chapter 418, Government Code, or a   |
| 10 | declaration of local disaster under that chapter, a building        |
| 11 | inspection for compliance with this subchapter or related municipal |
| 12 | regulations may, while the declaration is in effect, be performed   |
| 13 | by:   |
| 14 | (1) a person certified to inspect buildings by the                  |
| 15 | International Code Council;   |
| 16 | (2) a person employed as a building inspector by the                |
| 17 | municipality in which the building is located; or                   |
| 18 | (3) a person employed as a building inspector by any                |
| 19 | political subdivision, if the municipality in which the building is |
| 20 | located has approved the person to perform inspections during a     |
| 21 | disaster.   |
| 22 | (b) A municipality may not collect an additional inspection         |
| 23 | fee related to the inspection of a building performed under         |
| 24 | Subsection (a).   |

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1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
