- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter M, Chapter 74,
- 6 Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER M. UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SYSTEM MULTI-INSTITUTION
- 8 [HEALTH SCIENCE] CENTER [AT SAN ANTONIO CAMPUS EXTENSION]
- 9 SECTION 2. Sections 74.701-74.704, Education Code, are
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 74.701. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH CENTER CAMPUS
- 12 EXTENSION. The board of regents of The University of Texas System
- 13 shall establish and operate a <u>multi-institution center</u> campus
- 14 extension of The University of Texas Health Science Center at San
- 15 Antonio in the city of Laredo if:
- 16 (1) a public or private entity offers the board of
- 17 regents sufficient land in that city to construct a center campus
- 18 extension; and
- 19 (2) public or private entities agree to provide funds
- 20 necessary to construct an administrative building for the center
- 21 campus extension.
- Sec. 74.702. MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION OF CENTER CAMPUS
- 23 EXTENSION. (a) The board of regents may exercise any power granted
- 24 to the board under Subchapter D in establishing and operating the

- 1 center campus extension.
- 2 (b) The board of regents shall may assign responsibility for
- 3 management of the center campus extension to The University of
- 4 Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio an institution of higher
- 5 education.
- 6 (c) The operating costs of the center <del>campus extension</del> shall
- 7 be paid from the operating funds of The University of Texas Health
- 8 Science Center at San Antonio for that purpose and from available
- 9 funds from any public or private entity.
- 10 Sec. 74.703. GIFTS AND GRANTS. The board of regents may
- 11 accept and administer gifts and grants from any public or private
- 12 person or entity for the use and benefit of the center campus
- 13 extension, including accepting and administering gifts and grants
- 14 of land and physical facilities.
- Sec. 74.704. FACILITIES. (a) The physical facilities of
- 16 the center campus extension used in teaching and research programs,
- 17 including libraries, auditoriums, research facilities, and health
- 18 education buildings, may be provided by a public or private entity.
- 19 The board of regents is authorized to lease the facilities that are
- 20 to be used as the physical facilities of the center campus
- 21 extension.
- (b) A teaching hospital considered suitable by the board of
- 23 regents may be provided by a public or private entity. The hospital
- 24 may not be constructed, maintained, or operated with state funds.
- 25 SECTION 3. Section 74.705, Education Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
