Chapter 13, Property Code, is amended by adding 5 Section 13.006 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 13.006. EFFECT OF RECORDING QUITCLAIM DEED. After the fourth anniversary of the date a quitclaim deed for real property is 7 recorded in the deed records of the county in which the real 8 property is located, the quitclaim deed: 9 (1) does not affect the question of the good faith of a 10 11 subsequent purchaser or creditor; and 12 (2) is not notice to a subsequent purchaser or 13 creditor of any unrecorded conveyance of, transfer of, or 14 encumbrance on the real property. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 15 to a quitclaim deed recorded on or after the effective date of this 16 Act. A quitclaim deed recorded before that date is governed by the 17 law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and 18 that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 20
