- 5 SECTION 1. Section 33.0211(b), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The commission, [at least quarterly] until final
- 8 disposition of the complaint, shall notify the person filing the
- 9 complaint of <u>any change in</u> the status of the <u>complaint</u>
- 10 investigation unless the notice would jeopardize an undercover
- 11 investigation.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 33, Government Code, is
- 13 amended by adding Sections 33.02114, 33.02115, and 33.02116 to read
- 14 as follows:
- 15 Sec. 33.02114. COMPLAINT INFORMATION ON COMMISSION
- 16 WEBSITE. The commission shall maintain on the commission's
- 17 Internet website a statement that a complainant is not required to
- 18 maintain confidentiality of the complaint filed by the complainant.
- 19 <u>Sec. 33.02115. SANCTION GUIDELINES. The commission shall</u>
- 20 establish guidelines for the imposition of a sanction to ensure
- 21 <u>each sanction imposed is proportional to the judicial misconduct.</u>
- Sec. 33.02116. COMPLAINT SCHEDULE. The commission shall
- 23 <u>establish a schedule outlining times for commission action on a</u>
- 24 complaint. The schedule must allow the executive director to

- 1 approve an extension of time for complaint disposition due to
- 2 <u>extenuating circumstances</u>, including a need for further
- 3 <u>investigation</u>.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
