## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 2, Family Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 2.0091 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2.0091. APPLICATION FOR AND ISSUANCE OF LICENSE
- 8 THROUGH REMOTE TECHNOLOGY. (a) This section applies only in a
- 9 county in which the county clerk has been certified by the Texas
- 10 Judicial Council under Section 71.039, Government Code, to issue a
- 11 marriage license through the use of remote technology.
- 12 (b) In a county to which this section applies:
- (1) a person who applies for a marriage license
- 14 through the use of remote technology is considered to have appeared
- 15 before the court for purposes of this subchapter; and
- 16 (2) the county clerk may issue a marriage license
- 17 through the use of remote technology only in accordance with the
- 18 procedures adopted by the Texas Judicial Council under Section
- 19 71.039, Government Code.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 71, Government Code, is
- 21 amended by adding Section 71.039 to read as follows:
- Sec. 71.039. PROCEDURES FOR ISSUANCE OF MARRIAGE LICENSE
- 23 THROUGH REMOTE TECHNOLOGY. The council, in consultation with the
- 24 Department of State Health Services, by rule shall develop and

- 1 implement a voluntary certification process under which a county
- 2 clerk may be certified to issue a marriage license to applicants
- 3 through the use of remote technology in accordance with procedures
- 4 adopted by the council. The procedures adopted by the council must
- 5 ensure sufficient verification of each applicant's age and identity
- 6 to prevent fraud.
- 7 SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2022, the Texas
- 8 Judicial Council shall adopt the rules necessary to implement
- 9 Section 71.039, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
