6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 772, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 772.0065 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 772.0065. INELIGIBILITY FOR GRANT FOLLOWING CERTAIN
9	BUDGET REDUCTIONS. (a) In this section:
10	(1) "Criminal justice division" means the criminal
11	justice division established under Section 772.006.
12	(2) "Local government" means a municipality or county.
13	(b) A local government is ineligible to receive a grant
14	awarded by the criminal justice division if the division determines
15	that:

- (1) the local government has adopted a budget for a 16
- fiscal year for the sheriff's department or municipal police 17
- department, as applicable, that in comparison to the preceding 18
- fiscal year reduces the budget of the department by 5 percent or 19
- 20 more and the reduction is not due to a similar decrease in the
- amount of tax revenue collected by the local government; and 21
- (2) the reduction will have a significant, adverse 22
- effect on public safety within the applicable county or 23
- 24 municipality.

- 1 (c) A local government that is receiving money under a grant
- 2 awarded by the criminal justice division shall notify the division
- 3 of any reduction described by Subsection (b)(1) not later than the
- 4 15th day after the date the reduction takes effect. At the request
- 5 of the criminal justice division, the local government shall
- 6 provide a description of the reduction and any anticipated effects
- 7 on public safety.
- 8 (d) The criminal justice division shall require a local
- 9 government applying for a grant to:
- 10 (1) disclose whether the most recent budget of the
- 11 local government constitutes a reduction as described by Subsection
- 12 (b)(1); and
- 13 (2) provide a description of the reduction and any
- 14 anticipated effects on public safety.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 with respect to the adoption of a budget by a municipality or county
- 17 for a fiscal year that begins on or after the effective date of this
- 18 Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
