- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2004.004, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(a-1)</u> Raffle tickets for a charitable raffle conducted 8 under Subsection (a) may be sold:
- 9 <u>(1) at the home venue of the professional sports team</u>
 10 associated with the foundation conducting the raffle; or
- 11 (2) through digital interactive media, including an
- 12 Internet website of or mobile application provided by the
- 13 professional sports team associated with the foundation conducting
- 14 the raffle.

- 15 (a-2) Raffle tickets sold under Subsection (a-1)(2) may
- 16 only be sold to individuals physically located in this state at the
- 17 time of the sale.
- 18 SECTION 2. Sections 2004.002(1-a) and 2004.009(a),
- 19 Occupations Code, are repealed.
- SECTION 3. The repeal by this Act of Section 2004.009(a),
- 21 Occupations Code, does not apply to an offense committed under that
- 22 section before the effective date of the repeal. An offense
- 23 committed before the effective date of the repeal is governed by the
- 24 law as it existed on the date the offense was committed, and the

- 1 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 2 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 3 the repeal if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
